

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how **Solouno Ltd.** and its affiliates (“**Solouno**”) collect, use, and protect personal information from individuals (“**you**” or “**user**”) who visit, access, or use our website (the “**Website**”) and any related features, content, or services we offer, including via our application (the “**App**”, which together with the Website, shall be referred to herein as the “**Service**”). We are committed to protecting your privacy and safeguarding your personal information (as set forth below). Please read this policy carefully to understand how we handle your data and to help you make informed decisions. By visiting, accessing, or using the Service, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

1. TERM OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy takes effect when you first access or use the Service and will remain in force for as long as you continue to use or have access to the Service, or for a longer period if required under this Privacy Policy.

By using the Service, you explicitly consent to the collection, storage, use, and sharing of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy, including any updates made from time to time.

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices, technologies, legal requirements, or for other operational reasons. When we do, we will revise the “Last Updated” date at the bottom of the policy. If we make material changes, we will provide notice through the Service or by other means, as required by applicable law. Continued use of the Service after any changes indicates your acceptance of the updated Privacy Policy.

Please note that the Service may occasionally contain unintentional errors or inaccuracies. Solouno will make reasonable efforts to correct these as needed, at its sole discretion. While we regularly update and improve the content provided through the Service, some inaccuracies may occur during or between updates. Solouno does not accept any responsibility or liability for such errors.

We also make reasonable efforts to keep the Service free of viruses, but we cannot guarantee complete protection. Users are responsible for taking appropriate precautions, such as using antivirus software, before downloading any content from the Service.

2. OUR SERVICE

SoloUno provides a behavioral optimization and habit-tracking App, available for download via Google Play and the App Store, and accessible via a web browser directly at the URL, as well as an informational Website. Certain features of the Service are available only to registered users or paying subscribers. From time to time, SoloUno may also offer physical products or accessories as part of a subscription or promotional program.

When you access and/or use the Service, you provide consent for us to:

- Collect and process your Personal Information as described in this Privacy Policy.

- Use your information for the purposes specified herein.
- Share your information with third-party service providers as detailed below.

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us at omer@solouno.io. Please note that withdrawal of consent may limit or prevent your ability to use certain features of the Service.

For direct marketing purposes, we will only send you promotional communications if you have provided explicit consent, and you may opt out at any time as described in Section 5 below.

3. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Information You Provide

When you access or use the Service, Solouno may collect certain types of personal information (“**Personal Information**”) directly from you or based on your interactions with the Service. This may include:

- **Account Information:** When you create an account in the app, we collect your email address and profile preferences (name or nickname) which you choose to use.
- **Order and Payment Information:** When you subscribe to the Service, we collect the information necessary to process your transaction and manage your subscription, including your name, billing address, phone number, and email address. In certain cases, we may also request a delivery address to send you physical items or accessories included in your subscription plan. Payment details (such as credit card or banking information) are processed securely by independent third-party payment providers (such as Google, Apple via the app store) in accordance with industry standards. SoloUno does not store or have access to your full payment information on its servers
- **Habit and Behavioral Data:** Information you voluntarily enter into the app, including:
 - Habits you are tracking and their descriptions (if you so choose to provide us such information);
 - Daily metrics and progress data;
 - Situations and triggers you document;
 - Session recordings and notes related to each habit;
 - Goals, milestones, and personal reflections;
 - Daily check-ins;
 - Periodic checkups.
- **Communication Data:**
 - Correspondence with our support team;

- Responses to surveys or feedback requests;
- Message and support services (that may be managed by a third party).
- **Website Contact Form Data:** When you submit a contact form on our Website, we collect your name, email address and phone number and the content of your message.
- **Newsletter Subscription Data:** If you sign up for our newsletter, we retain your name and email address.
- **Usage and Transaction Data:** Details about your interactions with the Service, such as pages viewed, features used, time spent in the app, and frequency of use. This may also include communications with SoloUno and related metadata (e.g., timestamps, communication method, approximate geolocation).
- **Other Information:** Any additional personal data you submit through the Service.

Some of the information collected through the App may include sensitive Personal Information, such as details about your personal habits, behavioral patterns, emotional states, or mental health-related goals. We handle such information with appropriate technical and organizational safeguards and process it solely for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy and in accordance with applicable privacy laws.

We do not actively collect precise geolocation data. However, approximate location may be inferred from your device's IP address or general usage patterns, solely for analytics and security purposes. This does not include delivery or billing addresses that you voluntarily provide when subscribing to the Service or purchasing physical items. Such information is collected and used solely to process your orders and deliver the products or accessories you have requested.

Note: If you provide Personal Information about another individual (for example, when creating an account or subscription on their behalf), you are responsible for ensuring that you have the legal authority or that person's consent to share their information with us, and for informing them of this Privacy Policy.

Information Automatically Collected

In addition to the Personal Information you provide directly, SoloUno may automatically collect certain technical and usage-related data when you interact with the Service ("**Usage Data**"). This information helps us operate, secure, and improve the Service and your experience. Usage Data may include:

- **Device Information:** We may collect details about your device and its connection, such as your IP address, browser type, operating system, device model, approximate geolocation (based on IP address), and unique device identifiers (e.g., UDID, IDFA, AAID, or MAC address).
- **App Analytics Data:** Through third-party analytics services (such as **Mixpanel** and **Hotjar**), we collect information about how you use the app and website, including:
 - Features accessed and buttons clicked

- Time spent on different screens
- Navigation paths and user flows
- Session duration and frequency
- Error logs and crash reports
- Heatmaps and interaction patterns (Hotjar)
- **Push Notification Data:** Through OneSignal, we collect data related to push notifications, including:
 - Device tokens for notification delivery
 - Notification delivery status (sent, delivered, opened)
 - User engagement with notifications (clicks, dismissals)
 - Opt-in/opt-out preferences
- **Ancillary Technical Data:** We may collect additional technical and diagnostic data related to your use of the Service, including system configuration, usage patterns, login history, clickstream data, session metadata, application performance metrics, bug or crash reports, and system diagnostics. This may include IP address, username, device host name, and the general location at the time of the issue.
- **Cookies and Similar Technologies:** See below.

Together, the Personal Information and Usage Data described in this Privacy Policy are referred to collectively as the "**Information.**"

You are not legally required to provide us with any Personal Information. However, some of the information we request is necessary for us to provide you with access to and use of the Service. If you choose not to provide certain information, we may be unable to offer you some or all of the features or functionality of the Service.

Cookies and Similar Technologies.

Like many websites, we use cookies and similar tracking technologies to enhance functionality, personalize your experience, and analyze how users interact with our Service. Cookies are small text files stored on your device that help us recognize your browser over time. We may also use web beacons, pixels, or other technologies to collect information such as your IP address, the referring website, pages visited, browser characteristics, and whether you opened or interacted with emails sent by Solouno.

We use the following categories of cookies:

1. **Strictly Necessary Cookies** – Required for the operation of our Service and to enable basic functions such as page navigation, secure login, and shopping cart functionality. Without these cookies, the Service cannot function properly. Examples of data collected: session identifiers, authentication tokens.
2. **Performance and Analytics Cookies** – Help us understand how you use our Service, so we can measure and improve performance. These cookies allow us to count visits, identify traffic sources, and see which pages are most popular. Examples of data

collected: pages visited, time spent on site, referring website, general location (based on IP).

3. **Functionality Cookies** – Allow the Service to remember your preferences and choices (such as language, region, or items saved in your cart), and provide enhanced, more personalized features. Examples of data collected: language settings, user preferences, saved items.
4. **Email and Communication Tracking** – We may embed pixels in our email campaigns to understand whether messages were opened, forwarded, or interacted with. Examples of data collected: email open rates, link clicks, device type.

You can control or disable cookies by adjusting your browser settings. Please note that disabling cookies may affect your ability to use certain features of the Service.

In addition to cookies, we may use other technologies to collect information about your browsing behavior to recognize users and track their activities (such as whether an email was opened or a link was clicked). We may also use analytics services to understand how visitors engage with our website, such as Google Analytics. These services collect information such as your IP address, browser type, device identifiers, pages visited, and time spent on the site. This data helps us improve website performance and user experience.

We may use third-party advertising, attribution, and measurement partners (such as AppsFlyer) that deploy cookies, SDKs, pixels, or tags to (a) deliver targeted advertisements, (b) attribute installs and other conversions to specific advertising campaigns (for example, to determine whether a user who viewed or clicked an ad subsequently installed and used the App), and (c) measure the effectiveness of our marketing. These technologies may collect, receive, and track information such as device identifiers (including advertising IDs), IP address, browser and device information, and app/website activity and event data, and may track your activity across different websites, apps, and online services.

You can opt out of certain analytics and advertising cookies by visiting industry opt-out pages such as <http://www.aboutads.info/choices> (for U.S. users) or <http://www.youronlinechoices.eu> (for EU users).

Do Not Track Signals. Some browsers include a "Do Not Track" (DNT) feature that signals to websites you visit that you do not want to have your online activity tracked. Our Service currently does not respond to DNT signals. However, you can control cookies and tracking through your browser settings as described above.

By continuing to use the Service, you consent to our use of cookies and tracking technologies as described in this Privacy Policy.

4. HOW SOLOUNO USES THE INFORMATION

Solouno uses the information it collects in accordance with applicable laws and for the purposes described below. We've grouped these purposes into functional categories for clarity:

Operational Purposes

- To Provide and Operate the Service: Including account setup, subscription management, payment processing, and delivery of digital or physical components of the Service.

- To Verify Identity: To confirm user identity and maintain accurate account details.
- To Process Payments and Handle Customer Requests (via our third party providers): Including billing, refunds, exchanges, and customer support.
- To Maintain Functionality and Technical Stability: Monitoring uptime, fixing bugs, and ensuring access to Service features.
- For Record Keeping and Internal Management: Maintaining logs, audit trails, reports, and backups for compliance, accounting, and risk management.
- To Post Testimonials: If you submit a testimonial, you consent to us displaying your name (or, if you choose, a pseudonym) and comments on our Website or in our marketing materials.
- To Enforce Our Terms or Other Agreements: Including investigating and preventing potential violations.
- To Support Business Transfers: In the event of a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, or asset sale, your Personal Information may be part of the transferred assets, in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
- To Comply with Legal Obligations: As required by applicable law, regulation, legal process, or government request.

User Experience & Analytics

- To Improve and Personalize the Service: Enhancing the design, functionality, performance, and overall user experience based on individual preferences and behaviors.
- To Analyze and Monitor Use of the Service: Collecting analytics, usage trends, device identifiers, and behavioral insights to understand how users interact with the Website and optimize accordingly.
- To Conduct A/B Testing and Campaign Optimization: Measuring how users respond to messages, and user experiences to improve marketing performance.

Marketing & Advertising

- To Conduct Marketing and Advertising: Including sending promotional emails and offers, personalizing content and advertising based on your interests and behavior, and delivering targeted or retargeted ads across websites, social media platforms, and third-party networks.
- To Build User Profiles and Segment Audiences: Using behavioral data, purchase history, and technical identifiers (such as IP address or cookies) to create customer profiles, segment audiences, and infer interests or preferences to tailor content and marketing strategies.
- To Use Lookalike and Custom Audiences: Uploading hashed or anonymized data to advertising platforms (e.g., Meta, Google, Pinterest) to identify similar audiences or re-engage prior visitors.

- To Combine Data: Linking or combining the Information with data from other sources (including third parties, social media platforms, or advertising networks) to enrich user profiles and enhance service and marketing personalization.

Security & Risk

- To Detect and Prevent Fraud or Security Threats: Including unauthorized access, misuse, illegal activities, or other violations.
- For Cybersecurity and Insurance Purposes: Including managing insurance claims, technical diagnostics, and responding to incidents.

General

- For Other Internal or Business Purposes: We may use Personal Information for any other internal or commercial purpose reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with Solouno, or as otherwise permitted by applicable law. This may include developing new products or services, improving our marketing strategies, or analyzing trends in customer behavior.

5. YOUR CHOICES: OPTING OUT OF COMMUNICATIONS AND PERSONALIZED ADVERTISING

Marketing Communications and Newsletters

We may use your contact information to send you promotional communications, newsletters, special offers, product updates, and other marketing materials that we believe may be of interest to you. These messages comply with applicable anti-spam laws (including the CAN-SPAM Act) and include a clear way to opt out.

You can opt out of receiving promotional communications at any time by:

- Clicking the “unsubscribe” link in any email we send you;
- Following opt-out instructions in SMS messages (if applicable); or
- Contacting us at omer@solouno.io.

We will process your opt-out request within ten (10) business days. Even if you opt out of marketing messages, we may still send you important transactional or administrative communications, such as subscription confirmations, billing notices, or policy updates.

Data Collection and Personalized Advertising

If you wish for Solouno to stop collecting and using your personal information for marketing personalization or targeted advertising, you may email us at omer@solouno.io. Please note that this request:

- Will not apply retroactively; and
- Will not affect necessary service-related data use (e.g., to fulfill orders or detect fraud).

If you are using a mobile device, your device may also provide settings to limit or reset your advertising ID:

- iOS: Go to Settings > Privacy & Security > Tracking, or disable Apple Advertising under Settings > Privacy > Apple Advertising.
- Android: Go to Settings > Google > Ads, and choose “Opt out of Ads Personalization” or reset your advertising ID (AAID).

Please note that opting out of advertising does not disable ads entirely, but rather limits the personalization of the ads you may see.

Also, please note that your device or browser settings are managed by you, and SoloUno is not responsible for any limitations or continued data collection resulting from your device or operating system configuration

6. YOUR RIGHTS.

Depending on your place of residence, you may have certain rights regarding your Personal Information under applicable privacy laws, including but not limited to the Israeli Privacy Protection Law, the EU GDPR, and U.S. state privacy laws. These rights may include the ability to:

- Receive confirmation as to whether or not Personal Information concerning you is being processed, and access your stored Personal Information, together with certain supplementary information.
- Receive Personal Information you directly volunteer to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format.
- Request rectification of your Personal Information that is in our control.
- Request erasure of your Personal Information.
- Object to the processing of personal information by us.
- Request to restrict processing of your personal information by us.
- Request that we limit use and disclosure of your sensitive Personal Information (if relevant).
- Request not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing which produces legal effects or similarly significantly effects on you.

However, please note that these rights are not absolute, and may be subject to our own legitimate interests and regulatory requirements. Also, the exercise of some of these rights may make it impossible for us to continue to provide you with our Services.

If you wish to exercise any of the aforementioned rights, or receive more information, please contact us at omer@solouno.io.

We review all requests in line with the applicable law. To keep your information safe, we may need to confirm that the request comes directly from you (the data subject) or from someone you’ve authorized, and we may ask for proof of identity. Once verified, we’ll check the information you’ve asked about and get back to you as quickly as we can, and always within 30 days from when we receive your request. In rare

cases where a more complex review is needed, we may extend this period by up to another 30 days, and we'll let you know if that happens. If we cannot fulfill your request, in whole or in part, we'll explain why and let you know the legal reason for our decision.

7. DURATION OF INFORMATION RETENTION AND STORING

SoloUno retains Personal Information for as long as necessary to provide the Service and for up to seven (7) years thereafter, unless a longer retention period is required by law or for legitimate business purposes such as resolving disputes or maintaining backups.

We may retain Personal Information to comply with legal obligations (e.g., tax, audit, or regulatory requirements), resolve disputes, enforce our agreements and policies, or protect our legitimate business interests.

Usage Data (such as analytics and technical logs) is typically retained for shorter periods, unless it is needed to improve the performance or security of the Service, or if we are legally required to retain it for longer durations. We may retain de-identified or aggregated data that no longer identifies you personally for research, analytics, or statistical purposes, without time limitation.

We store your data with third-party hosting providers that supply the infrastructure and data storage necessary to operate our Website, App, and related services. As a result, your Personal Information may be transferred to, stored on, and processed on servers located the United States, or other jurisdictions where our hosting providers or their affiliates maintain facilities. SoloUno does not control the data storage practices of these providers but ensures that they implement appropriate technical and organizational safeguards and comply with applicable privacy and data protection laws.

8. SHARING INFORMATION WITH THIRD PARTIES

We may share relevant personal information with third-party service providers in order to operate our business and provide you with our Services, in accordance with the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy. Such sharing is limited to what is reasonably necessary and is subject to appropriate confidentiality safeguards.

Third-Party Service Providers

SoloUno works with various third-party service providers who may have access to your Personal Information, including, without limitations:

- **Bubble.io** (located in the United States): which provides the application development platform that powers our mobile app. Bubble.io processes and stores user data as part of the app's infrastructure. For more information, see Bubble.io's privacy policy at: <https://bubble.io/privacy>.
- **Mixpanel** (located in the United States): which provides analytics services that help us understand how users interact with the app, including feature usage, navigation patterns, and user engagement metrics. Mixpanel processes anonymized and pseudonymized usage data. For more information, see Mixpanel's privacy policy at: <https://mixpanel.com/legal/privacy-policy/>.

- **Hotjar** (located in the Malta/European Union): which provides website analytics and user experience tools, including heatmaps, session recordings, and feedback surveys on our website. Hotjar helps us understand how visitors use our website and identify areas for improvement. For more information, see Hotjar's privacy policy at: <https://www.hotjar.com/legal/policies/privacy/>.
- **OneSignal** (located in the United States): which provides push notification services that enable us to send you timely updates, reminders, and notifications through the app. OneSignal processes device tokens and notification engagement data. For more information, see OneSignal's privacy policy at: https://onesignal.com/privacy_policy.
- **Xano** (located in the United States): which provides cloud hosting, backend infrastructure, and database services for our application, including processing and storing user data and supporting API functionality. For more information, see Xano's privacy policy at: <https://www.xano.com/privacy-policy/>.
- **Loops** (located in the United States): which provides email messaging services that enable us to send you service-related communications (such as onboarding emails, account notifications, product updates, and other operational emails). Loops processes contact details and email engagement data (such as deliveries, opens, and clicks). For more information, see Loops' privacy policy at: <https://loops.so/privacy>.
- **RevenueCat** (located in the United States): which provides subscription management and in-app purchase infrastructure, including helping us process and validate purchases made through the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and manage subscription status. RevenueCat may process purchase and subscription-related information (such as product identifiers, transaction and receipt data, and subscription status). In addition, we may disclose Personal Information to:

- **Employees, contractors, service providers, and advisors.** Solouno may share Personal Information with its employees, managers, security personnel, legal or financial advisors, consultants, agents, suppliers, and subcontractors, as reasonably necessary for operating, supporting, or improving the Service.
- **Authorized service providers.** We may share information with third-party vendors that support the Service (such as cloud hosting providers, payment facilitators, CRM platforms, email distribution services, and analytics providers).
- **Payment processors.** We may share order-related information with third-party payment providers (e.g., Google, Apple, etc.) to securely process transactions and help prevent fraud.
- **Delivery and logistics partners.** We may share necessary personal information with shipping carriers and logistics providers to fulfill and deliver your orders.

In addition, we may also share your personal information with:

- **Affiliates and subsidiaries.** Solouno may share Personal Information with its affiliated companies and subsidiaries where such sharing supports our internal operations or service delivery.

- **Legal and regulatory purposes.** Solouno may disclose Personal Information when required to do so by law, regulation, court order, or legal process; or where necessary to enforce our rights, comply with legal obligations, respond to government requests, detect or prevent fraud, or ensure the safety and security of the Service and its users.
- **Business transfers.** In the event of a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, reorganization, or sale of Solouno's business or assets, Personal Information may be transferred to the acquiring entity, subject to the protections outlined in this Privacy Policy.
- **Aggregated and anonymized data.** Solouno may share de-identified or aggregated information that cannot reasonably be used to identify an individual. This type of data may be disclosed for purposes such as analytics, research, or marketing.

We do not sell your Personal Information to third parties for monetary consideration. However, under certain privacy laws (such as CCPA), sharing data with advertising or analytics partners may be considered a "sale" or "share." You have the right to opt out of such sharing as described in Section 5 above.

9. THIRD PARTY SERVICES; THIRD PARTIES COOKIES

Our Service may include content or features provided by third parties, such as embedded videos from YouTube or other media platforms. These third-party services may collect information about you when you interact with their content (for example, by playing a video), even if you do not leave our Website or App. Such collection and use of data are governed by the privacy policies of those third parties, not by this Privacy Policy. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of any third-party services you interact with. For example, to learn how YouTube (a Google service) uses data, visit: <https://policies.google.com/technologies/partner-sites>.

In addition, Solouno's Service uses cookies and similar technologies, including third-party tools such as Google Analytics, to help us understand how users interact with our Service and to improve performance. Please note that the use of cookies by these third parties is not covered by this Privacy Policy, and Solouno does not control how such cookies operate.

Disabling third-party cookies may affect the functionality of the Service. Even if third-party marketing cookies are disabled, Solouno may still share Personal Information with third parties for non-marketing purposes, such as:

- Fulfilling your requests or transactions;
- Responding to inquiries or providing customer support; or
- Ensuring system functionality or security.

Solouno is not responsible for the content, accuracy, or privacy practices of any third-party websites, services, or embedded content accessible through the Service.

10. INFORMATION SECURITY

Solouno implements industry-standard technical and organizational security measures to protect personal information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or

destruction. These measures include internal reviews of our data collection, storage, and processing procedures, as well as the security technologies used to safeguard information.

While we take reasonable steps to secure your information, please note that **no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure**. Therefore, Solouno cannot guarantee the absolute security of any information transmitted or stored. Access to Personal Information is strictly limited to Solouno employees, contractors, and service providers who need the information to operate, develop, or improve the Service. All such individuals are bound by contractual confidentiality obligations and are required to process information solely in accordance with this Privacy Policy and for the purposes for which it was originally collected.

In the event of a data breach that may affect your rights, SoloUno will notify you and the relevant authorities as required by applicable law.

11. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Your Personal Information may be transferred to, stored, and processed in countries outside your country of residence, including Israel, the United States, and other jurisdictions where our service providers maintain facilities. These jurisdictions may not provide the same level of data protection as your home jurisdiction.

Whenever we transfer Personal Information internationally, we ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place, such as data processing agreements and standard contractual clauses, to protect your information in accordance with applicable privacy laws.

12. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

The Service is intended for users aged eighteen (18) and older. We do not knowingly collect Personal Information from anyone under the age of eighteen (18). If you are a parent or guardian and believe that your child has provided us with Personal Information, please contact us at omer@solouno.io.

If we become aware that we have collected Personal Information from a minor under eighteen (18) without parental consent, we will delete such information as quickly as possible.

If any changes to this Privacy Policy affect users under the age of eighteen (18) in a way that requires parental consent under applicable law (including the U.S. Children's Online Privacy Protection Act – COPPA), we will obtain such consent before implementing those changes.

If SoloUno conducts any specific programs, campaigns, or activities directed at individuals under the age of eighteen (18), the terms and privacy practices applicable to such activities will be published separately and will comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including parental consent requirements where relevant.

13. MISCELLANEOUS

For any question, concern, comments or suggestions regarding this Privacy Policy, please contact Solouno at omer@solouno.io. This Privacy Policy applies globally to all users of the Solouno Service, and we will comply with applicable privacy laws based on your place of residence.

Solouno reserves the right at any time to modify this Privacy Policy. Any such modification will be effective immediately upon posting the amended Privacy Policy on the Service and/or by sending a notification to the users. Your continued use of the Service after the effective date of any such modification will be deemed acceptance of such modified Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy supersedes and replaces any prior versions or statements regarding our privacy practices.

All disputes arising out of this Privacy Policy will be subject to the governing laws of the State of Israel and the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent local and federal courts located in Tel Aviv – Jaffa, Israel. The user and Solouno agree and submit to the personal and exclusive jurisdiction and venue of these courts, except that nothing will prohibit either party from instituting an action in any court of competent jurisdiction to obtain injunctive relief or protect or enforce its intellectual property rights. The United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods shall not apply to the Terms.
